

Ordinance No. 2431 Summary

On November 16, 2017, the City of De Soto, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 2431 extending for one year the temporary discount program for fees associated with building residential structures within the City of De Soto, Kansas.

ORDINANCE NO. 2431

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING TEMPORARY DISCOUNT PROGRAM FOR FEES ASSOCIATED WITH BUILDING RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES WITHIN THE CITY OF DE SOTO, KANSAS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2277 the City implemented a temporary discount program for building permit fees for residential structures and, since passage of Ordinance No. 2277, the City has extended the program to continue to spur building within the City; and

WHEREAS, the program is scheduled to expire on December 8, 2017 but the governing body desires to continue the program until the Friday after the first City Council meeting in December, 2018, specifically **December 7, 2018**, and to consider any further extensions of the program (beyond December 7, 2018) at its regularly scheduled meeting on September 6, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DE SOTO, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the previously adopted temporary De Soto discount program for residential building within the corporate boundaries of the City of De Soto is hereby amended to remain in effect through **December 7, 2018** as set forth in the attached **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2. To allow for residential builders to anticipate the end of the discount program, at its regular meeting on September 6, 2018, the governing body will consider and decide whether the program should be extended beyond December 7, 2018.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication in the City's official newspaper.
