



City Guidelines



Cart Usage and Placement

Only refuse containers provided by HONEY CREEK DISPOSAL will be permitted for use. Place cart no closer than 3 ft. from any obstructions and within 3 ft. of the curb. Place cart with arrows facing the street and the handle facing your house. Cart must be out by 7 a.m. on the day of collection. Cart must be removed within 24 hours after collection.



No Trash Outside of Cart

All refuse set out for collection shall be fully contained within the provided refuse containers. No other refuse will be collected.

Suggestions for additional waste: You can request an additional container for \$3.00 a month or get a bag tag for \$1.00 from city hall.



Yard Waste

Leaves and grass must be placed in compostable craft paper bags specifically designed for yard waste. However, hedge and tree trimmings may be bundled provided the bundles are not more than 18 inches in diameter, 4 ft. long, and less than 75 lbs. in weight.



Debris not eligible for Collection

Lumber, carpet, building or remodeling materials, tires, chemicals, oil, paint, rocks, dirt, concrete, animal remains, and appliances containing refrigerant. Commercial or industrial waste or materials of an explosive nature.



Bulk Item Pickup

Bulk collection of larger items, such as household furniture, appliances, bicycles, etc... will be made on the 1st service day of your collection each month. Appliances containing refrigerant must be responsibly evacuated before disposal.



Holidays

No collection will be made on New Years Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day. If your trash falls on a holiday or a day succeeding the holiday, your trash will be picked up one day later than normal for the remainder of that holiday week. For example, if your trash day falls on a Tuesday during a holiday week, your trash will be picked up on Wednesday and so forth. Your trash collection will resume as normal at the start of the new week.

**If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, your trash will be collected on your regularly scheduled pick-up day.

Garbage Collection as you know it is about to change for the better!



De Soto's new residential trash collection system uses a specialized container that can be emptied by automated equipment, making garbage collection cleaner and safer. This program has been successfully implemented in other local cities and is now coming to the City of De Soto.

NEW CART FEATURES

- The carts are very stable and designed to resist falling over.
- The lids are snug-fitting, keeping animals out.
- The interior is smooth, making cleaning easier.
- The cart has a generous 95 gallon capacity.

BENEFITS

- This program will result in a more attractive curbside appearance in your neighborhood.
- The new equipment will reduce work-related injuries.

Each residence will receive one 95-gallon cart. Use of this cart is mandatory. If you should have more trash than the cart can hold, you can request an additional cart for \$3.00 a month or buy a bag tag for \$1.00 per bag from city hall.

Once the program starts, your current trash can will no longer be accepted. If you wish to have your old trash can removed, set your can at the curb and mark it (THROW AWAY).
